SUMMERTIME AT WESLEY MONUMENTAL

I loved the quiet sunsets when pretty much everyone else had left the course. As an adult, it's easy to turn these long days into longer than normal workdays. But, a spiritual discipline I might suggest (this week, especially on the summer solstice) is to watch a late evening sunset or an early morning sunrise and read the first chapter of John's gospel (especially v.1-5). Give thanks for the light. Life can take us into some dark places, but as John reminds us, the darkness cannot overcome the light.

We have launched our Sunday evenings at Wesley Gardens Retreat Center. It was a great start last week and we hope you will make time to spend a summer afternoon/evening with us on Moon River. The youth gather at 3:00 p.m. Spiritual Practices with Christian Swails begins at 4:00 p.m. Worship is at 5:30 (we are serving communion each week along with the singing and sermon), and dinner is at 6:15. Afterwards, you are welcome to take a walk, sit on the dock, watch the sunset and give thanks for the light. If you are out of town for the weekend or coming back from vacation but returning on Sunday afternoon, it is a great option for a relaxed and meaningful time of in-person worship. I hope to see you downtown or at the Gardens (or both) this week.
